GOD LOVES YOU SO MUCH

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only Begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" John 3:16.

This is the greatest message from God to you, springing from His bosom of love. It has been termed the greatest of texts because it carries the record of the greatest exhibition of the greatest love to the greatest company (the world).

Read it this way. "God (the Greatest Lover) so loved (the greatest degree) the world (the greatest company) that He gave (the greatest act) His only begotten Son (the greatest gift) that whosoever (the greatest opportunity) believeth (the greatest simplicity) in Him (the greatest attraction) should not perish (the greatest promise) but (the greatest difference) have (the greatest certainty) Everlasting life (the greatest possession).

It is an eternal fact that God loves you with an everlasting love that cannot be fathomed; this love is so boundless that it can only be known in His gift to the lost world. The little word (So) in the above verse is most expressive. It gives you the concept of the magnitude of God's love. God so loved you that He gave His only begotten Son to be a Saviour and a deliverer that you might find refuge and solace in His bosom.

Ask God to forgive you, invite Him into your heart, Promise Him that you will not go back to sin again. Thank Him for saving you in Jesus' name.

- 7. It is a fact that you are now a child of God. Begin a new life from now and grow in the experience.
